## MAJOR PROJECTS

### **1991 - 1996 Central Park**

An exploration of Central Park as a place of solace and serenity, reflected in part by the lack of people and buildings in the photographs. The woods, pathways, and rocks evoke for me a decidedly un-urban feel, which I constantly try to convey.

### **1982 - 1986 New York Harbor**

Initially a photographic documentation of New Jersey's Hudson waterfront on the brink of development, aided by a grant from ARCORP; later expanded to encompass the entire New York Harbor. Work has been exhibited in one-person shows at the Newark Museum and the Jersey City Museum and in numerous group shows; it is included in the permanent collections of the Museum of the City of New York, the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey; the towns of Rennes and Bordeaux, France, and private collections in the U.S., England and France. A slide presentation of this project opened major waterfront symposiums at Snug Harbor, Staten Island; the Marine Sciences Consortium, Sandy Hook, New Jersey, and the Jersey City Museum, Jersey City, New Jersey, and was shown at the Fulton Ferry Landing Museum and to the Architecture Department of the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey.

### **1967 - 1982 Hoboken**

Photographed Hoboken throughout its transformation from a working-class industrial town to an upscale, gentrified outpost of New York City, assisted by a grant from the New Jersey State Council on the Arts in 1978. Work from this project has been exhibited extensively and is in the permanent collections of the International Center for Photography, Channel 13 - Newark, and PSE&G Company, as well as numerous private collections in the United States and Europe.
